Context	<p>Issy-les-Moulineaux and Weiden are twinned cities since 1954. This twinning was one of the first to seal the Franco-German friendship, less than a decade after WWII. For more than 60 years now, citizens from Issy and Weiden have the chance to meet and discover the culture of one another thanks to school exchanges, sport exchange programs or discovery tours. Each year, at least 50 young people from Issy and Weiden have the opportunity to discover their twin city through school exchanges.</p> <p>As part of our Youth and International policies, Issy-les-Moulineaux and Weiden have decided to promote the international mobility and volunteer commitment of young people thanks to the French-German volunteering program lead by the AFCCRE and OFAJ.</p> <p>In this context, a civic service mission is available at the City Council of Issy-les-Moulineaux at the International Relations Department. It is an opportunity for a young German person to represent Weiden and the German culture, to take part in the cooperation between Issy and Weiden and to promote European values.</p>
